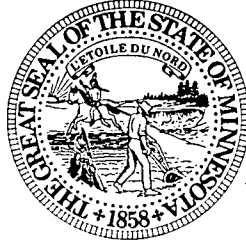

(hereinafter Permittee) is issued an Air Emission Registration Permit by the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency for its University of MN - Morris facility located at:


